The redemptive name, Jehovah-Shammah, is found in Ezekiel 48:35 and means, “The Lord is there,” or “The Lord is present,” revealing to us the redemptive privilege of enjoying His presence at all times and in every place. Jesus fulfills this when He says, “Lo, I am with you always” (Matthew 28:20).

The Redemptive Name Given

Ezekiel 48:35 KJV

*It was round about eighteen thousand measures: and the name of the city from that day shall be, **The LORD is there** (Jehovah-Shammah).*

The Redemptive Name Fulfilled in Christ

Matthew 28:18-20 KJV

*And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, **lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.***
