“And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, Speak unto Aaron and unto his sons, saying, This is how you shall bless the children of Israel, saying unto them, The LORD bless thee, and keep thee: The LORD make his face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: The LORD lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee peace” (Numbers 6:22-26).

God told Moses to speak certain words over the children of Israel to bless them. It is obvious that the reason God told Moses, Aaron, and his sons to speak those particular words was because what God told them to speak was what God wanted to do for Israel.

It seems that God couldn't just do those good things for Israel. It required a person (or people) to SPEAK before God could do.

God wanted to bless Israel, but couldn't bless them until faith-filled words of blessing were spoken over them.

Words of blessings spoken, *Loosed, Allowed, and Permitted* God to do what He wanted to do, but could not do, until invited to do it with human words (Matthew 18:18).

This story is just one of many that shows us the importance of speaking what we want – not what we don't want.

When you complain about your kids, your finances, your living conditions, and so forth, you are actually cursing what you want blessed.

For that reason, only use your words to paint the best and brightest pictures of the things that are dear to you.

God is enabled to move and work on planet Earth when we speak the Mighty Word of God and Call Those Things That Be Not As Though They Are (Romans 4:17).
