

Greetings Champion!

I will be teaching a Life Group in my home on Sunday nights from my new book, titled, "Winning the Battle." Although it's about the strategies and agenda of the devil, it's also about who we are In-Christ and the victory God wants us to walk in.

When we were "born again" we were rescued, delivered, and transferred out of the kingdom of darkness. True born-again believers are no longer under the jurisdiction and dominion of Satan's rule of darkness.

We are free from the dominance that Satan exercised over us in the past. Sickness, disease, fear, poverty, and sin can no longer rule over us if we walk in our redemptive rights. We have been translated, transferred, and transplanted into the kingdom where Jesus (not Satan) reigns supreme. *"Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son"* (Colossians 1:13,14).

Jesus rescued us from the jurisdiction and dominance exercised by the Powers of Spiritual Darkness! *"We are in the world but not of the world"* (John 17:14). It's true that, *"The whole world lies in the power of the Wicked One"* (1 John 5:19), but we are exempt from the Wicked One's power and control by believing in Jesus and what He has done for us, and who He has made us to be.

The laws that govern God's Kingdom are superior to the laws that govern the world system controlled by Satan. Our job is to discover God's laws and principles and deliberately and purposely operate them for our advantage. *"For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from (Satan's) law of sin and death"* (Romans 8:2). The more we operate the superior laws of God, the freer we become from the dooming laws of sin and death.

As Christians, we have been born of God. Fathered by God. The very LIFE and NATURE of God lives in us. We may miss it and sin. We don't, however, purposely make a habit of sinning, because sin is contrary to our new nature.

My encouragement to you is that you find out who you now are, now that Jesus is your Lord and Savior.
