The Bible revealed that God's plan for His people was *"to give them great and goodly cities, which they built not, and houses full of all good things, which they filled not, wells dug, which they dug not, vineyards and olive trees, which they planted not, and they were to eat and until they were full"* (Deuteronomy 6:10-11).

God's people in the Old Testament were to personally thrive, *plus* obtaining the blessings others worked to create. That's supernatural wealth, and supernatural wealth is for you!

"A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just" (Proverbs 13:22). God wants ***you to be "blessed above all people!"***

God clearly stated in Deuteronomy 7:14 (in seven short words), what *His will* is for all of His people, *"You shall be blessed above all people."* That verse includes every aspect of our lives, including financially.

In one of the final books in the Bible, we have revealed one of the most clear statements regarding prosperity found in the Bible. *"Beloved, I wish above all things that you may prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers"* (3 John 1:2). Here God is saying that His will for you is ***"supernatural wealth and divine health."***

Since God said that, He expects us to say that. Dare to speak it right now! ***"I have supernatural wealth and divine health in the name of Jesus!"***

If you are not used to declaring what God has spoken, making that statement probably felt uncomfortable for you. Here's the rub, if you intend to prosper and thrive the way God said you are supposed to, you must get comfortable with boldly saying what He says.

I am seriously expecting 2017 to be the best year of your life, so far. God wants that too, but He needs your cooperation in order to bless you, which will require a change in your mindset and in the words you speak.
