

Greetings Champion!

Proverbs 10:22 NLT), *"The Blessing of the Lord makes a person rich, and he adds no sorrow with it."*

In last week's email, we saw that Abraham was very rich and powerful. He was so rich and powerful that he had thousands of servants. Genesis 14:14, tells us that Abraham took 318 trained men, military age, born in his household and pursued and conquered four Kings.

Remember, Abraham was very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold. Plus, his camp was filled with women and children. It stands to reason that he didn't take every soldier he had to rescue Lot. He had to have left some trained men, military age, behind to protect the women and children, cattle, silver, and gold.

Let's say that Abraham left half of his army behind to protect his people, and his silver and gold and stuff. That means, he had at least 636 trained men who were military age born in his household. You do the math.

So we know for sure that Abraham must have had at least 636 trained men who were born in his own house. That means their mothers and fathers were servants of Abraham, and that triples the number of Abraham's servants right there. Now we know each of the 636 men had a mother and father that worked for Abraham, meaning that Abraham had 1,908 servants.

PLUS, it's likely that each man had at least one sister, one little brother, one wife, one son, and one daughter. That would mean that Abraham had thousands of servants and we are not even taking into consideration the fact that Abraham's commandos probably had more than one brother, one sister, one son, and one daughter. Again, you do the math.

I'm simply stating those facts to let you know that you are an heir of uncommon wealth and riches and yet because most of us have never been taught that, insufficiency has been our experience. God wants that to change in your life and wants to increase you exceedingly!
