Jehovah-Nissi. The redemptive name Jehovah-Nissi means, “The Lord our Banner,” or “The Lord our Victor” or “The Lord our Captain” (Exodus 17:15). This name can also mean, “The Lord Who Makes War.”

The Redemptive Name Given

Exodus 17:15-16 KJV

*And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it **Jehovahnissi**: For he said, Because the LORD hath sworn that the LORD will have war with Amalek from generation to generation.*

The Redemptive Name Fulfilled in Christ

Colossians 2:14-15 KJV

*Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; And having **spoiled principalities and powers**, he made a show of them openly, **triumphing over them** in it.*

It was when, Christ triumphed over principalities and powers (Colossians 2:15) that He provided for us, through the Atonement, the redemptive privilege of saying, “*Thanks be unto God which gives us the victory through our Lord, Jesus Christ*” (1 Corinthians 15:57).

Jehovah-Nissi can mean, “The Lord our Captain.”

Jesus is called, “The Captain of our salvation” in Hebrews 2:10 KJV.

Jehovah-Nissi is the Lord Who always causes us to triumph and always gives us the victory!
