

The Seven Compound Redemptive Names of Jehovah Pastor Glen Curry

In the Scofield Reference Bible, Dr. Scofield, in his footnotes on the redemptive names of Jehovah, says, “the name Jehovah is distinctly the redemptive name of deity,” and means “the Self-existent One Who reveals Himself.”

Because God is the *All Sufficient One* (Genesis 17:1), it could be argued that it’s impossible for Him to have any needs. He’s All Sufficient. Yet, in the name “Jehovah” it almost seems that there’s pressure on God (or at least a powerful desire) to reveal Himself to His covenant people.

Think of the pressure on a dam with billions of gallons of water being held back by the wall. It’s almost as if God is so desirous to reveal Himself to His people that He gushes out with revelations about Who He is.

Notice that God, in His redemptive work towards man, is called, “**The Self-existent One Who reveals Himself.**” Because it’s His nature and motivation to reveal Himself, it’s almost as if He cannot help revealing Himself, knowing that the revelation of Who He is and what He does, will help His people so much.

One of the ways He reveals Who He is, is by attaching *what He does*, to His name.

We could say that because of His great love, God is compelled to reveal more and more details about Himself to His people, for our benefit.

Take your name for example. Then, add what you do, or the different roles you play in your life, to your name. That would let us know much more about you.

Example: Glen Curry. Pastor Glen Curry. Dr. Glen Curry. Glen Curry the teacher. Glen Curry the husband. Glen Curry the father. Glen Curry the grandpa. Glen Curry the radio host. Glen Curry the author. Glen Curry the success motivation speaker. Etc.

The more information that is given about the different roles I play, the easier it is to understand me and anticipate how I can help you.

The seven redemptive names, Dr. Scofield says, “Point to a continuous and increasing Self-revelation.” He then says, “In His redemptive relationship to man, Jehovah has seven compound names which reveal Him as meeting every need of man.”

Since it is His redemptive relationship to us that these names reveal, they must each point to Calvary where we were redeemed.

The blessing that each name reveals must be fulfilled in the person and work of Jesus Christ. This the Scriptures clearly teach.

Verses About His Name

*Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? Who had gathered the wind in His fists? Who have bound the waters in a garment? Who hath established all the ends of the earth? **What is His Name and what is His Son's Name**, if thou canst tell? (Proverbs 30:4).*

*Holy and reverent is His **Name** (Psalm 111:9).*

*The **Name** of the Lord is a strong tower (Proverbs 18:10).*

*Thou art great and Thy **Name** is great (Jeremiah 10:6).*

*My people which are called by my **Name** (2Chronicles 7:14).*

*Therefore my people shall know my **Name**: therefore they shall know in that day that I am he that doth speak: behold, it is I (Isaiah 52:6).*

Remember, the name "Jehovah" speaks of Who He is, as God. *The Ever-Existing One. The Eternal Lord. He that always was, that always is, and that ever will be.*

The names added to Jehovah speaks of what He does.

I am the Self-Existent One, and I heal.

I am the Self-Existent One, and I am your peace.

I am the Self-Existent One, and I provide for you.

I am the Self-Existent One, and I lead you and guide you.

Knowing the Seven Compound Redemptive Names of Jehovah gives you an advantage in every way. If you can define your need, all you need to do is find one of His names that meet your need.

If you need a plumber, you don't call a carpenter.

If you need a medical doctor, you don't call a dentist.

By accurately calling upon the NAME of the Lord that meets your specific needs, you are assured that your needs will be met in a prompt and professional way by the God of this Universe.

You could pray; “Jesus, You said that You are Jehovah-Rapha to me. I believe You, and I receive the healing You purchased and provided for me now, for Your Name sake.” (Or in fulfillment of Your Name.)
