God clearly stated in Deuteronomy 7:14, in seven short words, what *His will* is for *all* of His people (including you). God said, "*Thou shall be blessed above all people.*" That verse includes every aspect of our lives, including financially.

In one of the final books in the Bible, we have revealed one of the most clear statements regarding prosperity found in the Bible:

*"Beloved, I wish above all things that you may prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers"* (3 John 1:2).

Some church leaders who insist on preaching poverty to their congregations, and try to explain-away the hundreds (if not thousands) of verses on prosperity, claim that 3 John 2 was John's personal wish for his friend Gaius, and not God's wish for His people. If that's the case, maybe John 3:16 was John's wish for his friend Gaius, and not really the will of God for the human race.

Additionally, if 3 John 2 is not *God's will* for His people, then not "*All Scripture is given by inspiration of God*" (2 Timothy 3:16).

It's important that you believe that it is God speaking to *YOU* when He says, "*Beloved, I wish above all things that YOU may prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers*" (3 John 2).

God wants *YOU* to experience *divine health* and *supernatural wealth*. And He wants you to experience it *before* you get to heaven.
