"The blessing of the Lord, it makes you rich, and he has no sorrow with it" (Proverbs 10:22).

Galatians 4:28 KJV, *"Now we, brethren, as Isaac was, are the children of promise."*

God connects us to Isaac, and states that as Isaac was a child of promise, so we also are the children of promise. For that reason it would be profitable to see *How* Isaac was blessed. Examining "The Blessing" that Isaac experienced shows us what we should be believing God for, and expecting since He connects us to Isaac in Galatians 4:22.

Genesis 26:1 KJV, *"And there was a famine in the land..."*

Genesis 26:12-14 KJV, *"Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundredfold: **and the LORD Blessed him**. And the man waxed great, and went forward, and grew until he became very great: For he had possession of flocks, and possession of herds, and great store of servants: and the Philistines envied him."*

Genesis 26:12 KJV, *"Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundredfold."* Here we see that, "The Blessing" caused Isaac to receive a 100 times greater harvest of fruit, grain, and vegetables than a seed normally and naturally produces. And that was in a time of famine when nothing would grow (Genesis 26:1).

In order to get in on that type of blessing where everything you do increases, you need to find out everything you can about "The Blessing" and believe God that you are the recipient of it.
