Blessing and increase, and power and might and dominion to you in the mighty name of Jesus.

Today, I would like to share with you a little bit about your free will. Bible scholars and pastors have told us that man is a free moral agent and has a free will. Bible evidence confirms, *"God won't violate man's free will."*

Obviously, the devil doesn't go by those rules. He pushes and shoves people to do his bidding; and if they yield, they are trapped. Consider Adam and Eve. They chose to obey the serpent over God, and God would not interfere. In His dealings with Israel, God wanted to be the King of Israel. Israel, on the other hand, wanted a human king like the other nations. God warned them about the downside, but let them choose, and they got a human king.

If a person is determined to do something, such as reject Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior, God will not force them to get saved. The price was paid to redeem every human being, but it's up to the individual to choose. For that reason, we must understand what the term, free moral agent means: The right to think, believe, do, and have what you choose.

A free will is simply your right to think what you want to think, believe what you want to believe, and do what you want to do. It is your right as a free moral agent, with a free will, to have the life you choose based on what you think and believe. *Whether your thinking and believing is right or wrong, productive or destructive, you must bear the consequences. God won't violate your free will to choose by forcing you to think only what He wants you to think. He tells you to renew your mind with the Word of God and explains what you should think about. But, in the final analysis, the choice to think what you want to think, is yours.*

That being the case, use your *free will* to think about something lovely right now. Take a few moments to think about actually possessing your very heart's desire right now. Visualize the fact that God has made you worthy to possess what you desire. He wants you to have what you desire and has provided it for you. Allow yourself to feel the thrill and happiness, right now, in advance, that you will feel when you actually possess whatever it is that you desire. Own and possess what you desire in your mind, and build on that confidence and feeling everyday until what you desire, shows up.
