God wants the rest of your life be the best of your life!

I have been sharing some prayer principles from my new book "Asking and Receiving God's Unlimited Provision."

At the tomb of Lazarus Jesus said, "Father, I thank you that you have heard me. And I know that you hear me always" (John 11:41-42). Know that God always hears you, too. This is a normal and truthful attitude and mindset for every child of God to embrace and maintain.

Also, a regular scheduled time and place for prayer is one of the most profitable of all disciplines.

Matthew 6:6, "But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you openly."

The term, "When you pray" implies a regular scheduled time set aside for prayer. Jesus didn't say, "If you pray."

Daniel had a discipline of praying at a certain time, three times a day (Daniel 6:10), and Peter healed a man at the temple while going to the regular scheduled "hour of prayer" (Acts 3:1-8).

Although God has made promises to do certain things, His relationship with Earth requires that a believing human asks Him to do what He has promised to do, before He can do it.

God setting the requirement that we must *ask*, before He will do, allows us to have a part to play in what God does on earth and makes us "Laborers together with God" to accomplish His Will on earth (1 Corinthians 3:9).

God would not have revealed His Will to us unless He intended on manifesting His Will to us. We are certain that the purpose of the promise is its fulfillment. In prayer, "We are laborers together with God" in manifesting His Will, and bringing His blessings to hurting humanity (1 Corinthians 3:9).
