All the blessings of God and life flow out of "The Blessing" that God gave to Adam and Eve, later to Abraham, and now to you (Genesis 1:28, 12:2-3; and Galatians 3:13-14).

The promises of God and what Jesus accomplished for you through redemption are the *Will* of God for you. Each believer must be convinced by the Word of God that what God promised and what Jesus accomplished is the *Will* of God for them. For it is impossible to have real faith for the answer to your prayers as long as there is the slightest doubt as to what you are asking for is God's *Will* for you.

If you want to know God's Will on any subject, read His Will.

*"If any of you lack wisdom (or provision, or healing, or anything else), let him ask of God, that gives to all men liberally, and upbraideth not (Meaning, "He will not rebuke you for asking," NLT), and it shall be given unto him. But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that waivers is like a wave of the sea, driven with the wind and tossed. Let not that man think that he shall receive anything from the Lord" (James 1:5-7).*

*"A double minded man is unstable in all his ways" (James 1:8).*

In other words, don't allow yourself to waver between two opinions when you know what God has said. Know that what God has promised and what Jesus accomplished through His great plan of redemption is a *sure thing, forever settled in heaven*, and don't waver and think the opposite.

Train yourself to be "single-minded" on the Word of God.
