I want to share some excerpts from my book, " Asking and Receiving."

So much praying is done without any regard as to whether or not God has promised the thing that is being asked for. Most Christians pray without any thought of believing and accepting the promise as a fact, and the answer, and the Will of God for them. They pray hoping that by some chance God might help them, without them knowing what the Word says.

That's not how it works! That's not how it's done!

You must believe that God's promise *is* God's answer! Believe it! Receive it!

If you want to obligate God to answer your prayer, you must take God at His Word and count it as a *forever settled in heaven fact* that you have the thing prayed for, according to the Word. "*For ever O Lord, your Word (your promise) is settled in heaven*" (Psalm 119:89).

Your job is to get God's Word and God's promises settled in you. "*The promises of the Lord can be trusted*" (Psalm 12:6, GNT).

All praying should be done on the basis of the promises of God, and what Jesus accomplished for you, when God raised Him from the dead.
